Beerhäus unveils weekly calendar of dining deals and entertainment

Monday, 10 May 2021: Beerhäus in Brisbane kicks off a value-packed, fun-filled calendar of fabulous deals and live entertainment this week, with something for everyone on offer at the super-charged, 40-tap social emporium in the heart of Bowen Hills.

From \$12, made-to-order, golden-crumbed schnitzels; to sauced up, 1-cent wings; and a weekly \$20 Sunday Roast – limited in availability, but unlimited in flavour – food-focussed guests have a line-up of unbeatable offers to indulge in at Brisbane’s largest taphouse.

Meanwhile, sports fans, trivia nerds and lovers of live acoustic music have back-to-back reasons to book a table at the beer-centric taproom, where they can soak up the pleasure-packed vibe and indulge in friendly competition over games of table tennis, pinball and giant Jenga.

From Wednesday 12th May, and every Wednesday thereafter, Beerhäus’ house-made, plate-sized schnitzels are just \$12 each all day (usually \$22-\$24), with the purchase of a full-priced drink.

Explore the Classic, featuring crumbed chicken breast, cabbage slaw, and mushroom sauce or gravy; the Parmi topped with double-smoked ham, mozzarella, napolitana sauce and fries; the Southern, showcasing a southern fried chicken breast with cabbage slaw, Frank’s hot sauce, Texas BBQ sauce and fries; and the Mushroom Parmi, which features crumbed confit mushroom, mozzarella, napolitana sauce, cabbage slaw and fries.

These legendary schnitzels pair perfectly with one of 40 freshly tapped drinks, including German beers by Löwenbräu, Franziskaner, Hofbräu, Spaten and Paulaner. The Bavarian line-up is bolstered by a range of Australian craft beers, including those by Green Beacon, Brookvale Union, Balter Brewing Company, Great Northern Brewing Company, Pirate Life and 4 Pines. British legend Bulmer’s, international standouts Peroni and Asahi, and Aussie icon VB join the taproom party, which showcases an eclectic line-up of beers, cider, sours, ginger beer, and house-made cocktails.

Guests can return on Thursday 13th May, and every Thursday thereafter, for classic 1-cent wings until 7pm. They are served smothered in one of seven sauces – from teriyaki to Texas BBQ, and chipotle to afterburner – with all levels of spice to explore. (Available with a full priced drink, maximum 10 wings per drink).

Triv-quiz groupies can reveal their wisdom over a beer or two at Cheeky Beaky Trivia Night every Thursday from 7.30pm. Thursday 13th May kicks off the brainiac sessions with the theme of *Friends*, followed by everyone’s favourite mum and daughter duo *Kath & Kim* (Thursday 20th May) and iconic teenage wizard *Harry Potter* (Thursday 27th May). The winning team takes home \$100, with \$50 for second place.

Fridays are for footy fans with games screened live across 20 large-screen TVs and \$1 wings on offer from 6pm (with a full-priced drink). Visit on Friday 14th May to see Manly versus Newcastle at 6pm and the Brisbane Broncos play Manly Sea Eagles from 8pm. This weekend Rugby League fans can indulge in the Magic Round, with all eight games screened live and loud over three days from Friday evening.

Explore Beerhäus’ \$10 cocktails on tap every Saturday, including Strawberry Margarita, Lychee Paradise, Appletini and Elderflower Garden.

On Sundays, guests can also feed their stomachs and their souls simultaneously with \$20 roast pork belly and live acoustic music sessions. German-inspired slow-roast pork belly, thick with golden crackling and served with glazed Dutch carrots, creamy mash, red cabbage, Yorkshire pudding, apple compote and onion gravy is available from 12pm until sold out each Sunday. Live acoustic vibes kick in from 1pm. Acoustic sessions are not available on UFC days, when fights are screened live across 20 large-screen TVs. This Sunday 16th May the UFC262 hurls Charles Oliveira against Michael Chandler in the lightweight main event from midday.
